Abstract: As we are aware non communicable diseases are becoming more now a days, 70% is from air pollution. Air pollution is a silent killer along with tobacco smoke-globally causing: 29% of lung cancer, 42% of chronic lung disease, 25% of Heart attack, 20% of Stroke. Recent study from Govt. Of India on August 19th 2021 report says, Northeast is cancer capital of India having: Oesophagus Cancer - 13.6%, Lung Cancer - 10.9%, Stomach Cancer - 8.7%.

For women

Breast cancer - 14.5%, Cervical Cancer - 12.2%, Gall bladder - 7.1%.

Lung cancer do not cause noticeable symptoms during the early stage until they become large and press on surroundings tissue or it spread to other organs.

Symptoms to watch:-

Persistent cough not going away, Persistent difficulty in breathing, Blood in the sputum, Feeling tired soon and weak, Persistent localised pain in the chest,

Pneumonia not clearing with treatment.

During the talk we cover the specific environmental issues as a causative agent and how best we can mitigate the lung cancer problem.
