Abstract: -

World Hepatitis Day is celebrated on July 28th in honour of Dr. Baruch Blumberg's birthday who discovered Hepatitis "B" virus in 1967 and developed vaccine in 1969. Hepatitis B is the preventable most common serious liver infection spreads by direct contact of infected blood and body fluid. Two billion people have been infected and 300 million people are living with chronic hepatitis infection. 1 million people die each year. Testing is the only way to know for sure if you are infected. Blumberg Institute for research started in 2003, Nearly 30 scientists working on chronic hepatitis, liver cancer in a conductive environment for interaction. During the talk the author will discuss other causes of hepatitis infection like hepatitis A,C,D,E and other causes followed by preventive measures.
