### Abstract: -

Vitiligo is a chronic skin disorder that causes patches of skin to lose pigment or colour. This occurs when pigment producing cells of skin the Melanocytes are attacked and destroyed causing the skin to turn milky white colour. Affect 0.5-2% of global population. It is more visible in people with darker skin tones and develop at any age but apparent before the age of 30 years and non contagious lifelong condition with no specific cure. It has significant psycho social co morbidities needing multi disciplinary approached strategy to educate the people.
