"World Patient Safety Day: Environmental Measures Needed to Safeguard the Patients in the Health Care Facilities" Abstract In the complex health care delivery environment, we have today, preventing inadvertent harm to the patients is the of utmost priority. Every point in the process of care-giving contains a certain degree of inherent unsafety. It is estimated that, approximately one in ten patients is harmed while receiving hospital care. World Patient Safety Day was established in May 2019 when the 72nd World Health Assembly adopted the resolution 'Global action on patient safety'. The WHO theme for the year 2023 is "Engaging patients for patient safety" Patient safety focuses on preventing and reducing risks, errors and harm that happen to patients during the provision of health care. Patient safety is a framework of organized activities that creates cultures, processes, procedures, behaviours, technologies, and environments in health care that consistently and sustainably lower risks, reduce the occurrence of avoidable harm, make error less likely and reduce its impact when it does occur. The measures needed to safeguard the patients in the healthcare facilities are many: Clear policies, organizational leadership capacity, data to drive safety improvements, skilled health care professionals and effective involvement of patients and families in the care process etc. are all needed to ensure sustainable and significant improvements in the safety of health care.
