Abstract: -

Hearing impairment is a major burden globally and in India as well. It constitutes a substantial 5.3% of the world population 4.6% to 8.8% in Southeast Asia and 6.3% in India. Hearing loss is largely preventable and avoidable condition. The environmental pollution has an important role in causing deafness. During the talk we will quote some examples, cover risk factors, how to recognize, treat and focus on preventive measures, adopting to our needs.
